
# Letter from our Executive Director

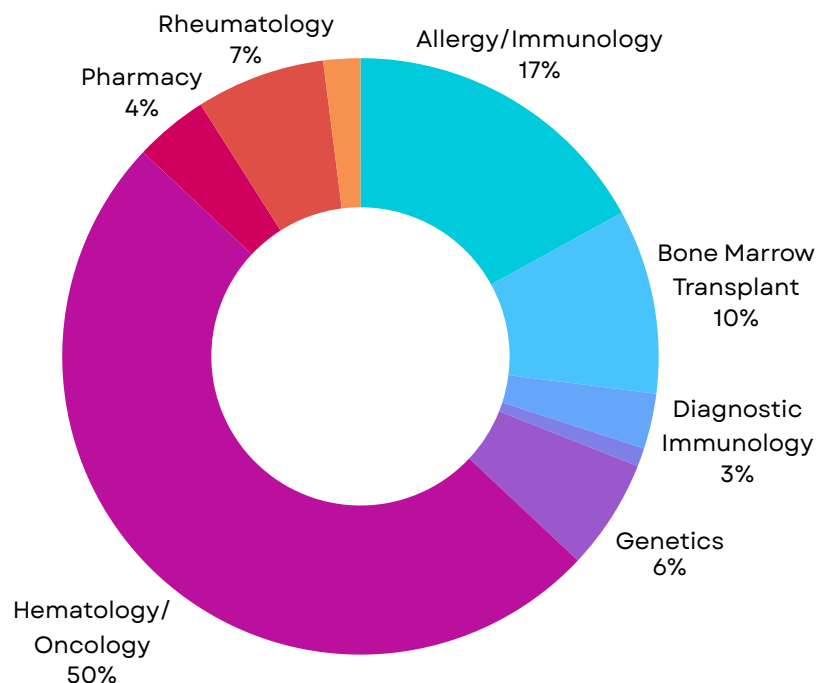
# Exhibit at NICER

At NICER, we strive to cultivate a collaborative atmosphere, acknowledging the vital contributions of our industry partners in furthering our shared mission.

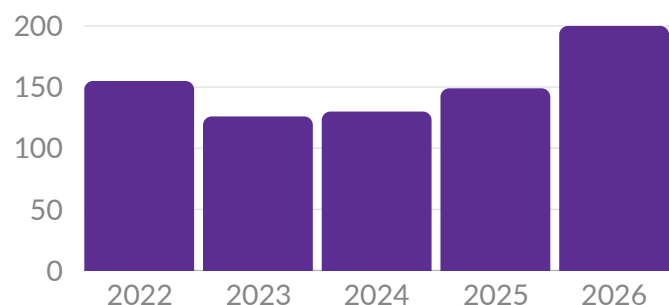
## Primary Specialties
